Time: Daily meetings according to the group you are assigned to between 9 AM - 5 PM

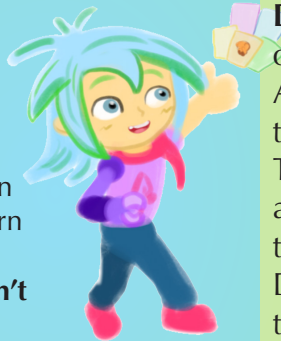
Where: Zoom Video Conferencing Technology from Tampa, FL and Los Angeles, CA
