Born with Arthrogryposis Multiplex Congenita, a rare disorder that causes limited joint movement and poor muscle growth, Luca “Lazylegz” Patuelli has created a unique dance style where he uses his crutches as extensions of his arms and uses the strength of his upper body to float around the dance floor! Lazylegz has performed in a wide variety of international dance events such as Breakin’ Convention, Freestyle Session, IBE, R16, Circle Prinz, World of Dance and Hip Hop International. Lazylegz headlined and was Segment Director for the 2010 Paralympic Opening Ceremonies in Vancouver. He has appeared on “So You Think You Can Dance Canada” and “America’s Got Talent,” and served as a lead dancer in the Théâtre National de Chaillot in Paris’s production of “Orphée”. Lazylegz is the founder of ILL-Abilities, a Bboy crew comprised of some of the world’s best differently abled dancers, which tours internationally.
