Blind from birth and a two-time kidney transplant recipient, Scott MacIntyre is a trained classical concert pianist who was a finalist on “American Idol.” MacIntyre studied music at the Royal Conservatory in Toronto and Arizona State University. In 2005, he received the coveted Marshall and UK Fulbright scholarships. He went on to receive a master’s degree from Royal Holloway, University of London and the Royal College of Music. In 2008, MacIntyre won the VSA International Young Soloist Award. MacIntyre has appeared on “Jimmy Kimmel Live,” “Regis and Kelly,” “The Today Show,” “Canada AM,” “Larry King Live,” “Huckabee,” and many other programs. In 2012, MacIntyre partnered with Donate Life America to launch a national PSA for organ, eye, and tissue donation and his song “I Am Hope” quickly became the theme song for the transplant community. His latest single “Look Up!” debuted at #1 on the Christian Radio Chart.
